*(March 2022) Northern Credit Union donates \$5,000 towards Ukraine conflict relief*

In response to the devastating and ongoing conflict between Russia and Ukraine, Northern Credit Union is donating \$5,000 to the [Canada-Ukraine Foundation Humanitarian Appeal](#), a non-profit organization established to support humanitarian projects focused on Ukraine. Donations help to provide and distribute food packages, medicine, and shelter to Ukrainian refugees who are seeking safety from the devastating Russian invasions.
